The overall consensus was:
    - i) Newton Construction's input was AH renovation was impractical due to condition of the building,
    - <u>ii)</u> Permitting process should be retained directly by the District which will include topographical survey, soils testing, site plan, architectural/historical review, hazmat tests, etc.,
    - iii) With the results of a hazmat report, Newton will provide a budgetary estimate for the demolition work including utility disconnect, capping and temporary power panel,
    - <u>iv)</u> District will ascertain what Monterey County requires in a permit package which will involve discussion with PMS (or alternate supplier) and County Building Department, and
    - v) Newton Construction personnel took AH building measurements to prepare a demolition estimate.
